## Archaeological Museum of Patras

The New Archaeological Museum of Patras is a museum located in the city of Patras, Greece. It houses collections about the history of Patras and the surrounding area from prehistory to the end of Roman times. The museum has four thematic sections, three of which are permanent and one is periodic. The periodic section will be hosting various exhibitions around the year. According to the archaeologists of the 6th Antiquity Conservancy, the 70% of the items exhibited are seeing the light of day for the first time in the past thirty years. (http://www.ampatron.gr/)

### Roman Odeon (Conservatory) of Patras

The Roman Conservatory of Patras is a magnificent building from Roman times that has today been reconstructed and is used for musical events. It is located to the west of the Castle, in the Upper town next to the Roman stadium and between the streets of Old Patras Germanou, Sotiriadou, Pantokratoros and Agios Georgios Square. It faces south and is covered with bricks, today its stairs are covered with marble.

# **Apollon Theatre**

The "Apollo" Municipal Theater was founded on 11/2/1871 on the north side of George I square and was put into operation on 10/10/1872. Its architect is Ernst Ziller, who designed three rows of gallery galleries with many decorative elements inside, while its Neo-Renaissance style facade is characterized by the portico with five arched openings that is repeated on the floor. #### **Patras Castle**

The Medieval Castle of Patra, Peloponnese: The Medieval Castle of Patra is built on the highest spot of the town, right above the Roman Odeon. Constructed on the site of an ancient Acropolis in the 6th century BC, this castle was captured by the Franks, the Byzantines, the Turks, and others. It was continuously in use till the Second World War and it protected the town in times of war and sieges.

#### Mycenaean Cemetery of Voudeni

The Mycenaean cemetery of Voudeni along with the Mycenaean settlement at the locality of Bortzi, comprise the Patras Mycenaean Park, located near the settlement of Voudeni (also known as Skioessa) of the Municipality of Patras in Western Greece. The archaeological site of a total area of 180 acres is located at an altitude of 220 meters, 7 kilometers northeast of Patras, has been transformed into a recreational park. It includes 78 carved tombs and the ruins of a prehistoric settlement, possibly identified with that of ancient Mesatis.
